Fundamental Rights of Person (07/12/2000 The Charter of F.R.)

<u>PREAMBLE</u> ... the Union *is founded* on the indivisible, universal values of *human dignity, freedom, equality and solidarity*; it is based on the principles of democracy and the rule of law....

<u>SOCIAL SECURITY</u> – Art. 26 - 3. In order *to combat social exclusion and poverty,* the Union recognizes and respects the right to social and housing assistance so as to ensure *a decent existence* for all those who lack sufficient resources...:

<u>HEALTH CARE</u> Art. 35 : Everyone has the right of access to preventive health care and the right to benefit from medical treatment under the conditions established by national laws (???)

Eurostat: In 2022, **95.3 million people** in the EU were at risk of poverty or social exclusion; this was equivalent to 21.6 % of the EU population. *Giving voice to those who no longer have* 'Overcome the poverty is not one charitable gesture, it's one act of justice, an act of protection of a fundamental right, the right to dignity and to decent life' (Nelson Mandela)
